PAMPLEMOUSSE SOUR

Layers of zesty pink grapefruit influences really make this sour zing, Herradura Blanco, pink grapefruit liqueur, house charred pink grapefruit syrup, grapefruit bitters, fresh lemon juice and egg white

PIRELLIS BLOODY RETURNED

A Bloody Mary with a certain camp flair, cherry toms and house spice mix are muddled with Absolut vodka, tomato juice and topped with a splash of shiraz

A SIMPLY SMASHING SCOTCH & SODA

The simple drinks are always the best, Auchentoshan 12yr old is combined with orange wedges, mint, fresh lime, sugar and bitters, finished with a splash of soda. This drink allows Auchentoshan's lighter side to really sing

GIN, PEACH & THYME COBBLER

Beefeater Gin, Californian viognier, white peach puree, fresh lemon juice and thyme are shaken hard and poured dirty delivering a complex and herbaceous long drink

RUM & RAISIN OLD FASHIONED

We combine the deep rich chocolate flavour of Venezuelan Pampero Anniversario rum with the sweet raisin flavours of Pedro Ximenez sherry to give you a classic drink with a decadent flavour combination

LEMON & EARL GREY SOUR

A sharp and light sour using grey goose citron, house earl grey syrup, fresh lemon and orange bitters, what's better than a wee cuppa earl grey?

CUCUMBER & MINT SMASH

Cucumbers are not just for sandwiches anymore, here we combine it with Zubrowka bison grass vodka, fresh lime and mint. Capped off with apple juice this libation is full of fresh green flavours

BELLINI

First devised by Giuseppe Cipriani in Harrys Bar, Venice in 1945 this drink is still a favourite today combining white peach puree and Prosecco. Fruity, dry and pleasantly peachy

THE VELVET UNDERGROUND

The Dominican Republic's Brugal extra aged rum combined with Caribbean flavours of velvet falernum, house pineapple syrup and fresh lime juice creates a tiki style drink that will have you reminiscing of warmer shores

Wines

WHITE

SPEE' WAH VIOGNER, AUSTRALIA - £18

Peach, taut fruit and lychee with a twist of citrus on the nose

ESK VALLEY SAUVIGNON BLANC, N. ZEALAND - £21

Passion fruit and citrus, a touch of herbaceousness and a lovely long finish

OMRAH UNOAKED CHARDONNAY, AUSTRALIA - £21

A peachy nose, a twist of lemon, creamy and hints of minerality. A crisp clean finish with both fullness and finesse

PINOT GRIGIO DI LENARDO, ITALY - £21

Full of apple and pear notes, a stunning citrus acidity that knocks socks off other pinot grigios

RED

TILIA CAB SAUV/MERLOT, ARGENTINA - £18

Soft flavours of plum, dark cherry and blackcurrant. Full bodied and smooth after taste

LIONS TOOTH SHIRAZ, SOUTH AUSTRALIA - £21

Bold red with hints of violet on the edges, rose petal aromas, berries and a little lime marmalade

EMILIANA PINOT NOIR, CHILE - £21

From Chiles largest organic producer, packed with strawberry fruit flavour, hints of mocha and spice, 20% of the wine being aged in French oak barrels for 8 months

BERONIA RIOJA RESERVA, SPAIN - £21

Barrel aged for 18 months and then aged for a further 2 years in bottle before release, hints of chocolate, toasted bread and spice on the nose, a smooth gentle finish

ROSÉ

ESK VALLEY MERLOT/MALBEC, NEW ZEALAND - £21

A vibrantly fruited wine, strawberries and red fruit predominate, a spice note adding complexity, dry in style with crisp acidity and a long finish

LES CERISIERS, COTES DU RHONE, FRANCE - £21

Pale and very elegant rose with a soft plump texture, delicate red fruit flavours combine with hints of white pepper

SPEYSIDE

ABERLOUR A'BUNADH £4.75

Orange, black cherries, dried fruit and ginger spiked with dark bitter chocolate and enriched with sherry and oak.

BALVENIE DOUBLEWOOD £3.95

Sweet fruit, honey and vanilla, mature, nutty cinnamon spices, warming finish.

GLENROTHES SELECT RESERVE £4.50

Vanilla, coconut and plums, malty, medium sweet hints of orange.

MACALLAN GOLD £4.15

Sweet vanilla, dark chocolate, boiled sweets, citrus, soft oak notes and toasted apples.

MACALLAN AMBER £5.50

Floral, citrus sweet nose, sweet vanilla, raisins and sultanas, notes of toffee apples, a subtle linger of oak.

MACALLAN SIENNA £6.95

Warm vanilla nose turned zesty and sharp with orange zest, fresh green apples. Date, figs and raisins with orange and nutmeg.

MACALLAN RUBY £12.95

Rich dried fruit notes and treacle. Sweet at first, with oak notes coming through. Ginger, nutmeg and sweet dried fruits on the palate

MACALLAN 21 £19.95

The Macallan 21 has been triple cask matured to give the whiskey more complexity on the nose and palate. Each cask leaves its own mark in the whiskey with each different cask taking its turn to impart a different flavour on the palate.

Vanilla and passion fruit, with orange and peat flavours, a lingering finish.

MACALLAN 40 £69.95

Only 450 bottles ever produced, the only non-vintage 40 year old ever to be released by The Macallan. It was released originally as a Travel Retail exclusive 3 years ago and sold out extremely quickly. Orange zest, dark chocolate, cinnamon, with a touch of wood smoke.

THE MACALLAN OSCURO 1824 COLLECTION £34.95

An extremely limited release, the macallan oscuro is drawn exclusively from oak casks seasoned with oloroso sherry, an exceptionally high proportion of which are first fill giving it its name oscuro being the Spanish for 'dark'. Ripened woodland fruit, dark chocolate and creamy vanilla on the nose followed by dried figs, ripe orange and a hint of crisp green apple

Apples, candied fruits, spicy toffee, sweet ginger finish.

Malty nose with marmalade, honey and chocolate. A long, spicy finish.	
GLENGOYNE 10	£3.50
Clean, smooth and warming taste. Fresh green apples, oak and toffee with a sweet malty finish.	
GLENGOYNE 18	£6.95
Apple compote, Christmas pudding and oranges in syrup. Hints of pear drops, vanilla and a slight nuttiness.

Very fruity with rich lemon, apples and spices. Tiramisu finish.

Dried fruits, beeswax and malted barley. A long finish with a herbal edge.

Honey, lemon, appetising fruitiness with a long smooth finish.

SPRINGBANK 10 £3.95
Citrus fruit, pears and a hint of peat, vanilla essence and cereal sweetness.

SPRINGBANK 15 £5.95
Fruit salad, caramel and pineapple. A long warm finish.

Peat, gentle oak and blossom tones with a barley fudge sweetness, long and spiced finish.

ISLE OF JURA SUPERSTITION £4.00
Delicate peat smoke, honey and spices. A long, rich, fruity, smoky finish.

HIGHLAND PARK 12 £3.50
Floral, honey, citrus and cream. Long peppered spice finish.

HIGHLAND PARK 18 £10.95
Floral, heather, espresso and cinnamon. Long and sweet finish.

HIGHLAND PARK 30 £29.95
*Until the arrival of the 40 year old, this was the plus ultra of the standard range of proprietary bottles from Highland Park. A whiskey of extraordinary depth and intensity of flavour. Whiskey Bible 2010: Best Single Malt (28-34 Years); 95.5 points.
Dark golden in colour, mature oak, chocolate, fudge, soft honey, nutty toffee.*

Smoked meats, sea salt, apple peels and coastal air. Thick and long finish.

TOBERMORY 10 £3.50
Rolled oats and honey, bitter chocolate touch, stewed bramley apples and oak

TOBERMORY 15 £6.95
A subtle sea influence, candied fruits, chocolate raisins and a salted caramel tang

Peat notes, espresso, treacle sweetness and liquorice.	
ARDBEG UIGEADAIL	£5.75
<i>Taking its name from the Loch which provides the peat-laden water for Ardbeg. An intense symphony of smoky peat reek, fruit cake and leather.</i>	
BOWMORE 12	£3.75
<i>From the original Islay distillery, this is a warm and delicious whisky with a subtle dark chocolate and a peat smoke.</i>	
BOWMORE 15	£5.75
Sherry, spices, creaminess and sweet dates. Spicy finish with toffee, sherry and barley.	
BOWMORE 18	£9.75
Citrus, damp wood, plums and peat smoke, finish of Seville marmalade, blossom and dark peat.	
BUNNAHABHAIN 12	£3.95
Fresh, sweet sea air, nutty, malty sweetness.	
CAOL ILA 12	£4.15
Peppermint, damp grass and cigar leaves, long, peppery finish, smoky with spicy warmth.

Peat, sherry and oak. Treacle sweetness and deep smoke.

<i>Barley, lemongrass, sweet stewed fruits and oak. A medium length finish.</i>

Honey, resin and oak, cooked fruit and nuts. Long, oaky, cocoa finish.
